The A. Margaret Boyd Overseas Fellowship was developed to promote international good will and understanding through study, travel, visits in homes, and observation of schools.

THE FELLOWSHIP

A stipend of up to \$6000 is available for study in any overseas country for up to one year. Members are usually enrolled in an overseas program accredited by a United States College or University.

A stipend not to exceed \$4000 is available annually for travel and study.

QUALIFICATIONS

*Applicant must have been a member of The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International for at least three (3) years and hold current membership in an Ohio Chapter.

*Applicant shall indicate how the overseas study will be applicable to teaching, community service, Delta Kappa Gamma programs, etc

*Applicant should visit homes and schools (if possible) and get to know the people of the country.

APPLICATION

An application form is available from the Chairman of the Selections Committee Foundation. (First Vice President of Alpha Delta State)

The completed application is to be returned to the Chairman of the Selections Committee.

The deadline for the return of completed applications is February 1st.

PROCEDURE

Upon receipt of all completed applications, the Selections Committee will make recommendations to the Board of Trustees of the A. Margaret Boyd Overseas Foundation.

The Board of Trustees will decide the distribution of fellowships to applicants, based upon the recommendations of the Selections Committee.

Upon completion of the fellowship work, the recipient shall:

1. Submit a written review to the Trustees.
2. Submit an article for *The Voice*.
3. Present a display/workshop at a state, regional, or international meeting.
